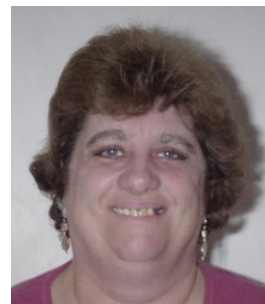
We have several upcoming events that the Administrative Team is working on. As you
